Steve Wallace is an award-winning singer and composer from Chicago, IL and most recently a composer with Theatre Now NY's Writer's Lab and BMI's Lehman Engel Advanced Workshop for composers and lyricists where he is the recent recipient of the esteemed Harrington Award for creativity in musical theater. He's released 15 albums as artist and has worked on countless other albums as well as TV/Film. His "Four Seasons" film score won the award for best musical score at the 2021 Diversity at Cannes film showcase. In 2010 his United Nation's Humanitarian Day song; "Be A Humanitarian" was in the running for Grammy Awards the same year. Steve Wallace has written a book of 14 art songs, 2 symphonies, 3 operas, 4 musicals including the REMI (Worldfest Houston) award-winning animated short "Humpty's Hatching Day".

Daniel Abrahamson is an award-winning composer and lyricist in Toronto, ON. He composed the scores for "Funny Business" (Best of Fringe, published by Samuel French), "Act Now" (Best of Fringe), and "Hugh and I" (Patron's Pick). He's the 2019 recipient of the Tom Hendry Award for Best Musical in Development from the Playwrights Guild of Canada for "Stars of Mars" which premiered at Sheridan College February 2020. In May 2020 his new musical "Super School!" premiered at Bravo Academy and was an O'Neill Festival Semifinalist in NYC, where Daniel is a member of the Advanced Class in the BMI Lehman Engel Musical Theatre Workshop and sold out a concert of his songs at 54 Below in March 2019 and Birdland Theatre in December 2019.
